Age UK Hackney Restructure and future funding	David updated members about the recent restructure within Age UK Hackney to say that there had been no changes contrary to original thought. Funding continues until March 2013
Jan 2 2 3	David informed Comms Team members that he has met with LBH officers who are happy with the way things were going, but would get an update from Dona Randolph (Direct Payments Manager) regarding Direct Payments Forum.  As for the year 2013 – 2014 a funding application will have to be made and submitted. David believes there will be some constraints such as funding from £58.000 to £40.000. David commented that he was of the opinion that there were funds to do some work, Maureen informed that the fund left over was for consultants fees. Maureen explained that she had spoken with Fiona Bear (the consultant who will build a business plan). Choice is contracted to and will do regular report.
